

The Storehouse of World Vision Family/Individual Membership Agreement

Responsibility of the Sponsoring Pastor/Organization

By sponsoring, I am not assuming any liability or responsibility for the family/individual's management of the product.

1. Verify that the family/individual is in need of product at the Storehouse.
2. Notify the Storehouse if aware of any misuse of membership or materials.

Responsibility of the Member

1. Pay an annual membership fee:

2. Adhere to membership guidelines.
3. Photo identifications must be presented upon entrance of the Storehouse to verify membership.
4. Families/individuals are responsible for keeping membership up to date.
5. Members of the Storehouse agree to have their name listed as users in the Storehouse internal and external communications. Photos taken at the Storehouse may also be used.
6. Agree that all building materials received are used only for the member's personal property.

Membership Guidelines

1. The Storehouse relies on donated materials, so our stock often changes with no guarantee that any product will consistently be available.
2. **The Storehouse is cash and carry site; personal checks are not accepted.**
3. Examine items carefully. There are no warranties or guarantees implied or intended. There are no exchanges or refunds; All transactions are final and "as is. **"Credit"** will only be issued on faucets with manufacturer's defect; credit must be used within 30 days.
4. This is a self-service warehouse. It is the responsibility of the family/individual to bring his/her own tools for measuring, to make pick-up arrangements and provide helpers to load materials. However, should staff or volunteers be available, they will gladly provide assistance as needed. No holds will be allowed.
5. Items cannot be procured and left at the Storehouse.
6. Children must be under direct supervision of a parent or guardian at all times.
7. No smoking, drugs, alcohol, firearms or pets are allowed in the Storehouse.
8. No materials are to be taken from the Storehouse until they have been checked and receipt is visible.
9. Project description and destination of the materials must be provided on receipt.
10. **Materials cannot be resold, used in commercial or non-member projects, or resold on auction sites for profit purposes.**
11. Merchandise quantity may be limited.
12. **The Storehouse reserves the right to revoke membership at anytime if these guidelines are violated.**

Abuse of Membership

1. **The Storehouse reserves the right to make on-site inspections to ensure products are being used for personal home improvement projects and affordable housing only. Product cannot be sold, bartered or traded.** Products are not to be used for business purposes, including rental properties or for re-sale.
2. Theft of product or any illegal activity will be immediate grounds for membership termination, without recourse to membership reinstatement.
3. Any grievances or dissatisfaction with the services provided by the Storehouse or the Storehouse staff should be discussed with the Storehouse General Manager. If this is not satisfactory, the member may submit a written description of the problem and proposed resolution to the Storehouse Advisory Council.
